Curriculum Overview for Music

At Johnson Fold we aim for music to be an inspiring and engaging subject! We believe that music should be an integral part of a child’s learning in order to stimulate and cater for a child’s creativity and that this should happen every day!

Music is an important part of our balanced primary curriculum. It provides children with a means of expressing themselves, explaining their world and communicating with others. The school programme of study gives our children the chance to investigate and explore sound using a wide range of instruments and media.

Singing happens daily in Johnson Fold, whether it is part of our daily assembly session, or our whole school weekly “Big Sing”, or to assist with delivering other areas of the curriculum. Children enjoy taking part in solo, group and whole class singing.

We are extremely proud of our very successful choir which is available for all children in KS2. They work very hard and celebrate with performances throughout the year which include the Bolton SMA Music Festival, Last Choir Singing Competition and performances within our local community.

Instrumental teaching is a fantastic part of our music curriculum and children within Key Stage 2 have the opportunity to learn the violin, guitar, clarinet or flute, either in a small group or whole class setting.
