


Kingfishers

Terms 3 & 4



English

We will be basing our writing on the book 'Around the World in 80 Days'. The children will write character descriptions of Phileas Fogg and they will describe the various settings along his journey. We will also be writing to inform, through diary entries and biographies and autobiographies.

RE

We will look at the creation story and what Christians learn from it. We will also look at the instructions God gives to humans to look after the world.

PE

We will continue to work on a range of skills with the sports coaches and then also start dance.

Art/DT

In art, we will be drawing landscapes from around the world using pencil. In DT, we will be using a range of stitches in a sewing project.

Topic

Our topic is Geography-based and we will be learning all about our world. In term 3, we will be exploring the question 'What is the most important thing in the world and who owns it?'. In term 4, the children will learn about the oceans and continents and major physical features of the world. We will be contrasting the UK to France and Russia. The children will also learn how to use and make a simple map of the local area.

Music

Recorder lessons will continue once a week.

Maths

The children will spend time becoming more confident at multiplying and dividing using formal written methods. They will also be learning about different measures, including length, perimeter and money and then explore a range of data representations in statistics.

Science

We will be investigating light and shadows in term 3 and then learning about forces and magnets in term 4.

Computing

We will continue exploring Scratch and also be using Word and touch-typing programs.

PSHE

We will be exploring the units "Friends and family" and "looking forward".

French

We will be learning to tell a story in French and also learning colours and food.
