

Subject	Unit description
<b>Functional Skills</b> <b>Maths, English, Computing</b>	Students will be working towards the AQA unit award scheme. This includes English, Maths and Computing. They will be working on a variety of tasks to prepare them for future assessments.
<b>AQA</b> <b>Skills for Independent Living</b> <b>Skills for Social Well Being</b> <b>Skills for the Workplace</b> <b>Skills for Leisure</b>	Students will be working towards qualifications covered by the AQA unit award scheme. The qualification will be divided into units covering Communication, Numeracy, ICT, Home Management, Personal Skills and In the Workplace. These units are: Health and safety/ Working with others in the workplace Shopping in a shopping centre Preparing drinks and snacks Safety in a car park Being healthy
<b>Work Experience</b>	Some students will have local external placements and others in-house placements. They will follow a qualification in Work-right or AQA units relating to their place of work.
<b>Science</b>	Students will cover electrical safety, changing materials, being healthy, recycling, health and safety, temperatures and plants/growing throughout the different aspects of the curriculum
<b>Humanities</b>	Students will learn about current affairs and other special days which take place during the Spring Term: This includes things such as Pancake day, St Georges day, Mother's day, Chinese new year and Easter
<b>Drama</b>	Students will take part in lessons which will be led by St. Anne's Drama teacher. This term they will rehearse and perform in the 2017 Rock Challenge competition.
<b>Community</b> <b>Practical Maths &amp; English</b>	Students will visit a variety of supermarkets, shopping centres, town centres. The students will locate items, identify different types of shops and ask workers in the shops for assistance when necessary. There will be opportunities to use cafes in the community to experience using money to purchase drinks and snacks.
<b>PSHCE</b>	Students will work on the Jigsaw programme following the dream and goals topic. Students will learn to identify their own successes and achievements through working within groups and partnerships. They will also learn about the feelings associated with success and appropriate ways to celebrate achievement. Students will be encouraged to tackle new challenges.
<b>PE</b>	Team Games and developing skills-The students will develop skills to then take part in team games ready for upcoming sports events. These will include: throwing, catching, batting and following instructions etc.
<b>Expressive Arts</b>	This term students will be completing their work on the jewellery unit. They will then look at different genres of dance focusing on country dancing and may pole dancing, before making up their own dance.
<b>RE</b>	This term students will cover identity and values, thinking about who they are and what they believe. They will also think about what others think and how they feel.
