Communication, Language & Literacy

Mathematics

- Learn order of and write numbers to 10
- Reliably count objects to 20 and beyond
- Use 10 frames, dice arrays and numicon to help quick counting
- Number comparisons, greater / smaller etc.
- Use appropriate mathematical vocabulary
- Discover different strategies to help with simple number sentences, including the part part whole method
- Add and subtract using objects, numbers and fingers
- Increase mental maths skills
- Number rhymes, songs and stories
- Sort and compare different objects by weight, size and capacity
- 2D and 3D shapes
- Recognise and use different coins 1p – 10p

Creative Development

- Respond to different pieces of music.
- Copy simple rhythms.
- Explore percussion instruments.
- Loud & quiet and high & low sounds.
- Collage / clay / printing / painting.
- Observational drawings.
- Role play areas
- Sing a variety of songs

Physical Development
