Dear Parents/Carers,

In the second half of this term, Year 3 will be designing and improving some Greek clothing as part of our Design & Technology project.

The piece of clothing is called a chiton which is a big square of cloth, held in place by pins at the shoulders and a belt around the waist. It would be helpful if the children already had their chiton pre-made so that they can focus on embellishments using their sewing skills.

A simple way of making a chiton is to cut two arm holes and a head hole in an old pillow case (preferably not patterned). Please see the diagram and picture (after embellishments have been added) below for further information.

These plain chitons could be worn on Greek Day on **Monday 28<sup>th</sup> January**, before we embellish them later in the term. Alternatively, your child may wish to wear their own costume for Greek Day and keep their plain chiton for embellishing.
