Where in the World?



In English we will learn about:

- How to spell words ending in 'ous' , words spelt with 'sc' and words with the 'ay' sound with different spellings.
- How to spell words from the Y4 key word list.
- Stories with imaginary settings.
- Fronted adverbials.
- Writing speech using layout and inverted commas correctly.
- Widening our vocabulary through reading different genres, including poetry and playscripts.
