English

We will be reading the texts

- Little Red Riding Hood – we will sequence sentences to retell the story and practise using speech bubbles.
- Animals that hunt at night – We will focus on the meaning and structure.
- Owl Babies – Looking at plurals, vocabulary, past tense and joining clauses.

Maths

We will concentrate on place value within 50, including multiples of 2, 5 and 10. We will also be looking at measurement. We will learn:

- Numbers to 50 and how to represent them
  - One more one less
- Ordering numbers within 50
- Count in 2s, 5's and 10's
- Compare lengths and heights

Reading

Your child will have the opportunity to bring home at least **two books a week**. One will be a library free choice book, and one is reading book pitched at their level of ability. Every child needs to bring a book bag into school each day. Please sign the reading records when you have read with your child at home and the book can be swapped for a new one.

Homework

Homework will be given out on **Mondays** and will be expected back in by **Monday**. This term children will have maths, phonics/English homework each week. Children will also be given a topic themed creative piece of homework to be completed over a period of time.
