<p><u>Maths</u> Measure out ingredients in grams and bake a cake fit for a Royal banquet.</p>	<p><u>English</u> Write a fact file/biography about one of the current members of the Royal Family.</p>	<p><u>Science</u> Which materials are best suited for these objects: castle walls, drawbridge, armour, bow and arrows, window and throne?</p>	<p><u>Art</u> Draw or paint a portrait of yourself as a King/Queen.</p>
<p><u>ICT</u> Create a photo-page using photos of different castles. Can you label each part?</p>	<p><u>D + T</u> Design your own Coat of Arms.</p>	<p><u>Music</u> Make a song about the Monarchy to the tune, 'If you are happy and you know it.'</p>	<p><u>Geography</u> Using a map, find and locate 5 different castles in the UK. Label the castle with its name and where it is.</p>
<p><u>RE</u> Who is St George? Find out about him and draw a picture of St George.</p>	<p><u>PE</u> Can you create a Royal soldier march that follows the beat of your favourite song?</p>	<p><u>History</u> Find and write down 4 interesting facts about a previous British King or Queen.</p>	<p><u>English</u> Retell one of your favourite fairy tales that includes a castle/knight/prince/princess/king or queen.</p>
