Why do you like this story so much?</p>	<p><b>Personal, Social and Emotional Development</b></p> <p>What makes you special? Talk about this with somebody at home.</p>	<p><b>Physical Development</b></p> <p>Please practise using a pair of scissors and holding a pencil correctly. Can you cut straight/zig-zag /curved lines? Can you trace/draw over lines?</p>
<p><b>Literacy</b></p> <p>Look at/read a book about a princess/prince/king/queen /castle with an adult and tell them all about the characters, setting and what happens in the story.</p>	<p><b>Mathematics</b></p> <p>Go on a 2D/3D shape hunt at home. How many 2D/3D shapes can you find? Can you name them all?</p>	<p><b>Understanding the World</b></p> <p>Bring in some pictures to share about how you celebrated Christmas holidays with your family. What did you eat? Where did you go?</p>
	<p><b>Expressive Arts and Design</b></p> <p>Can you draw/colour/paint/collage a picture of a castle? Bring it in for display in class.</p>
