


Homework Grid – Year 2

Reading	Spelling	Times Tables	Topic
<p>Read your reading book to an adult for at least 15 minutes <u>EVERY DAY</u>. Ask the adult to sign your reading record.</p>  <p>Explain to an adult what you think will happen next.</p> <p>Which is your favourite character and why?</p> <p>Where is the story set?</p> <p>Can you retell the story to someone else in your own words?</p> <p>Visit a library.</p>	<p>Learn your weekly spellings. These will be in your homework folders and tested on a Friday.</p> <p>Practise your spellings <u>EVERY DAY</u> There are ideas for ways to practise on your spelling sheet! This will be checked on a Friday. Don't forget to tick each day you practise on your sheet too!</p>  <p>Can you explain the spelling pattern to an adult?</p> <p>Look for your spelling words in the books you are reading. Can you work out what they mean?</p> <p>Use a dictionary to find the definition.</p>	<p>Practice your times tables. Once you know them in order try mixing them around. Can you still answer them quickly? Do you know the division?</p> <p>Start by learning your ten times table. Once you're confident with these, you can move on to 5s, 2s and 3s.</p>  <p>Listen to times table songs.</p> <p>Use Times Tables Rockstars to help you practise your tables.</p> <p>Practise the maths we've been learning in school this week at home. Can you explain it to someone else?</p>	<p>There may be times when individuals or the whole class will have written homework relating to a specific area we have covered in class. This will be compulsory and a hand in date will be clearly communicated in the homework folder.</p>  <p>We are learning about different kinds of art this term.
