<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Find out how to write Roman numerals from 1-10. Find a king or queen with a Roman numeral in their title and write it in words.</p>	<p><u>English</u></p> <p>Write a biography about one of the current members of the Royal Family.</p>	<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>Find out about Alexander Graham Bell's famous Victorian invention. Create a presentation to show what you have learnt.</p>	<p><u>Art</u></p> <p>Draw or paint a portrait of yourself as a king/queen. Remember to think carefully about proportions.</p>
<p><u>ICT</u></p> <p>Use ICT to create a poster or power point all about castles. Remember to include pictures and text.</p>	<p><u>D + T</u></p> <p>Create a dish fit for a royal banquet. Take/draw pictures of yourself making the dish and use them to create your own recipe.</p>	<p><u>Music</u></p> <p>Listen to 'Consider Yourself' from the musical, 'Oliver!' How does the music make you feel? Do you like the song? Why?</p>	<p><u>Geography</u></p> <p>Find out the locations of 5 different castles in the UK. Use a map to show where each castle is.</p>
<p><u>RE</u></p> <p>Create a storyboard to show the story of St George and the Dragon. Include speech bubbles to show what different characters in the story might be saying.</p>	<p><u>PE</u></p> <p>Can you create a royal soldier march that follows the beat of your favourite song?</p>	<p><u>History</u></p> <p>Research a British king or queen from the past. Record at least 4 interesting facts that you have found out.</p>	<p><u>English</u></p> <p>Rewrite a fairy tale, in your own words, that includes a prince/princess/king or queen.</p>
