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| <p>Dinosaurs</p>  | <p>Investigate</p> <p>Choose your favourite dinosaur. Find or draw a picture of a dinosaur. Find out; what did the dinosaur look like? What did the dinosaur like to eat? Where did the dinosaur live?</p> | <p>Dinosaur Habitats</p> <p>Dinosaurs lived in lots of different habitats. Discover where different dinosaurs lived. You could write about, draw or make a dinosaur habitat.</p> | <p>Imaginative Writing</p> <p>Use pictures of dinosaurs to make up your own dinosaur. Give your dinosaur a name and use adjectives to describe what your dinosaur looks like.</p> | <p>Information Station</p> <p>Find some nonfiction books about dinosaurs. Use the books to find out as much information as you can about dinosaurs for our information station.</p> |
| <p>Planes, Trains and Automobiles</p>  | <p>Make</p> <p>Find some recycled materials and make your own plane, train or automobile. Take photographs to stick in your book or bring it in to show the class.</p> | <p>History</p> <p>Find pictures of old trains or cars. Compare them with the trains or cars we have today. How have they changed?</p> | <p>Journey Map</p> <p>Take photographs on your next journey in a car or on a train or even a plane. Map your journey with pictures.</p> | <p>Information Station</p> <p>Can you find out anything exciting about planes, trains or cars? Bring it in to put up on our information station for the class to read.</p> |
| <p>Animals Including Humans</p>  <p>Animals Including Humans</p> | <p>Guess the animal...</p> <p>Draw some pictures/ write down the names of some animals. Describe the animals to your family or friends. You could tell them where it lives/ what it likes to eat? Can they guess which animal is on the card from your clues?</p> | <p>Den Building</p> <p>On a walk or in your garden find lots of wood from trees to build a small den for animals to live/ hide in.</p> | <p>Humans</p> <p>Draw a picture of yourself. Can you label parts of the body and can you explain the role of each part?</p> | <p>Information Station</p> <p>Choose your favourite animal. Can you find out any interesting facts about this animal?
