Topic— Could you be a Mountaineer?

Geography: In Geography we will be learning all about mountains. We will be looking at how mountains are formed and identifying the location of the major mountain ranges of the world. We will also investigate in more detail the height, population, features and origins of some mountains. We will then begin to look at mountain climates and the effect that tourism has. We will read the book 'King of the Cloud Forests' as part of our topic.

Design and Technology: As part of our electrical systems topic, we will be looking in detail at how circuits are constructed and, when making our own circuits, learn how to check the components effectively and problem solve if a circuit does not work correctly. We will be looking at the different uses of torches and how a torch is constructed, then construct our own.

RE: In RE this term we are looking at celebrations related to key figures. We will look at the stories of the lives of key religious people, the significance of these in the children's lives and in the lives of believers today.

Computing: We will be starting a new topic linked to shape and weather. Using software, children will create a simple code (a set of instructions), to design and draw a repeating pattern, and explore a range of apps including iMovie and using green screen technology to produce a weather/ news report.

Science: This term our focus is all about space! We will look at Earth, our position in our solar system and the wider universe as whole. We will take part in a range of experiments including answering the question: 'what makes a good landing module'? We will read the book 'Cosmic' as part of our topic.
