Welcome back. I hope you have had an enjoyable Christmas break. Here is a quick summary of what your child will be learning more about this term.

Our topic will now be 'Passport to the World' in which we look at three very different countries and compare their geographical features and their way of life with life here in Britain. You will find further details below.

I have suggested ways that you can support your child at home; feel free to complete any additional research of your own and bring it in to share with the class.

Topic— Passport to the World

Geography— We are going to take a trip around the world and make an in-depth study of some new, intriguing localities. We will be looking at 3 contrasting counties located around the world and using our research skills to find out about the climate, culture, way of life and geographical features of India, Kenya and Britain.

DT— We will be undertaking a delicious food technology project where we design and make a mouth watering menu based on the traditional cuisine of the countries that we are studying.

Science— In Science we will be investigating light, sight and how we see things. We will also be studying the human body and learning how the heart and circulatory system works within our bodies.

Computing— We will be using computing skills to design and write a computer programme using simple algorithms.

Music— Our Music topic this half term is a singing project that reinforces the use of pitch, pulse and rhythm. We will be listening to jazz and rap music and comparing these styles. We will even be trying to keep the beat and compose our own lyrics to music.

RE— We will look at religious artefacts, stories and artwork from different faiths and look at the messages that they spread.
