Hope you all had a lovely Christmas. The children have come back to school full of beans and ready to learn. We've got lots done already 😊

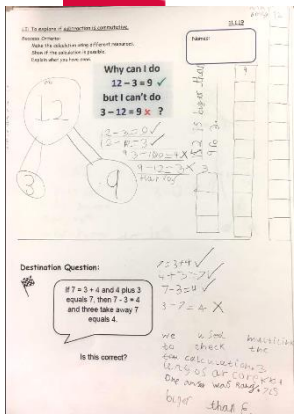
Writing

Our first TT Rockstars Battle starts this weekend! Please play as much as you can before Fri 18th Jan!

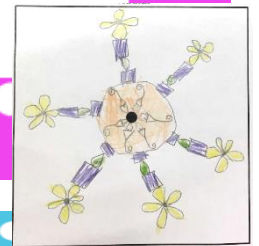
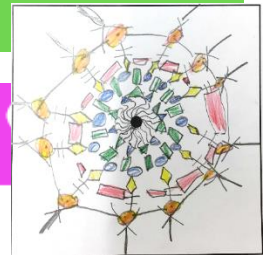
Maths

There has been so much fantastic maths this week! We have been reordering numbers in calculations to prove that addition can be done in any order ($4+3+1=8$ and $1+4+3=8$) but that subtraction cannot. I have been impressed with their explanations of their learning.
