


The Wonderful World of Oliver Jeffers



All of our Enquiry Led Learning work this term will stem from the work of Oliver Jeffers and the books that we will read.



National Curriculum

As **Geographers** we will be comparing the Antarctic to the United Kingdom; in particular how animal's habitats compare.

As **Design Technologists** we will be planning, making and evaluating structures of transport types. We will be selecting and joining different materials to do this.

As **Artists** we will using a range of different media, from paint to collage, to recreate illustrations in the style of Oliver Jeffers.

As **Musicians** we will create our own music to reflect settings that we have studied in Oliver Jeffers' books.

As **ICT experts** we will be following a program of coding and learning the basics of word processing.

As **scientists** we will look at growth, the basic needs and hygiene of all living animals including humans. We will study the habitats of different animals that live both locally and around the world. We will study forces and describe basic movements.
