EVERY MINUTE COUNTS!

Reading with or to your child at home is so important in supporting their vocabulary development.

Did you know that?

If a child reads 1 minute each day and 180 minutes in a school year they will learn 8,000 words

If a child reads 5 minutes each day and 900 minutes in a year they will learn 282,000 words

If a child reads 20 minutes a day and 3,600 minutes in a school year they will learn 1,800,000 words

Congratulations to all those children who received their Reading Star Awards in our Celebration Assembly this morning for reading 50 and 100 times at home - I am sure that they have learnt lots more new vocabulary so far this school year!
