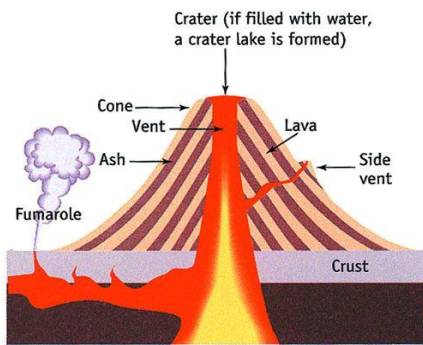




In RE, the children will:

- Make links between the stories of Zechariah, Mary and Joseph..
- Describe some actions and symbols of advent

Ask questions about what is most valuable in life and answer questions about trusting and Mary and Joseph.



In Science, the children will:

- Explore the adaptations of animals and plants that live in extreme environments.
- Explore condensation and evaporation in relation to the water cycle.
- Understand how Natural disasters such as volcanic eruptions and earthquakes happen.

In art, the children will:

- Use paints to create an Egyptian sunset.
- Create pharaohs using tissue paper and layering.

In Maths, children will:

- Multiply by 10, 100, 1 and 0
- Divide by 10, 100 and 1
- Multiply and divide by 6, 7 and 9 and know these times-table facts

Become more confident with all times-tables up to 12.

In Geography, the children will:

- Explore the Earth's extreme climates.
- Look at the water cycle and water distribution.
- Look in to Earthquakes, Volcanos Tsunamis and Flooding

In history, the children will:

- Explore the most famous Natural disasters: Mount Vesuvius.
- Create a presentation/fact file on one of the most famous disasters and compare to one more recently

In literacy, the children will:

- Write a range of texts based on the theme.
- Read and respond to a range of texts, building on their vocabulary and developing their skills of inference and deduction.
- Learn how to use the past perfect and present perfect tenses.
- To use appropriate time adverbials to suit the text type.
