

UNIFORM POLICY - September 2018

We encourage children to take pride in their uniform and to develop good habits of smartness as they grow-up. We hope you will help us to do this by considering the following expectations when you are dressing your child in the mornings and when you next come to purchase uniform.

The following options are acceptable:

- Bottle Green jumpers/sweatshirts/cardigan (with the school crest) - available from suppliers in town with list available at school office
- Black or dark grey trousers, non-fashion 'school-type' skirt or shorts.
- Gold/yellow polo shirt
- Black footwear (We strongly prefer that these should be black school shoes).
- A green and white striped or gingham dress can be worn with a green school cardigan as an additional choice for the warmer months.
- Outdoor footwear must be safe and appropriate for outdoor play.
- Warm school-type tights, if worn in colder months should be plain dark grey or black (no other colours are acceptable)
- If socks are worn, these must be white or grey.

GENERAL.

- All children should have a pump bag or shoe bag to hold footwear and PE kit that is not being worn.
- PE kit should be a white T-shirt / polo shirt, black pumps and black shorts (or tight black leggings).
- Trainers are needed for the Summer for outdoor PE and a tracksuit for colder months.
- For safety reasons, jewellery such as wrist bands, bracelets, necklaces and rings are not to be worn.
- Children with pierced ears may wear small studs (not 'fashion studs such as diamonds, skulls, patterned, shaped, dangly etc.).

- Designer or casual clothing is not acceptable for school wear unless it is a Non-Uniform Day.
- Hair clips and ribbons etc. should not be 'fashion' items such as brightly coloured flowers, large bows etc. No nail varnish or nail extensions and no make-up.
- If you have to allow your child to have dyed hair we ask that this is kept to the Summer holidays only. The same goes for tracks in hair and extensions.
