*'Loving to learn as we build friendship and faith'*

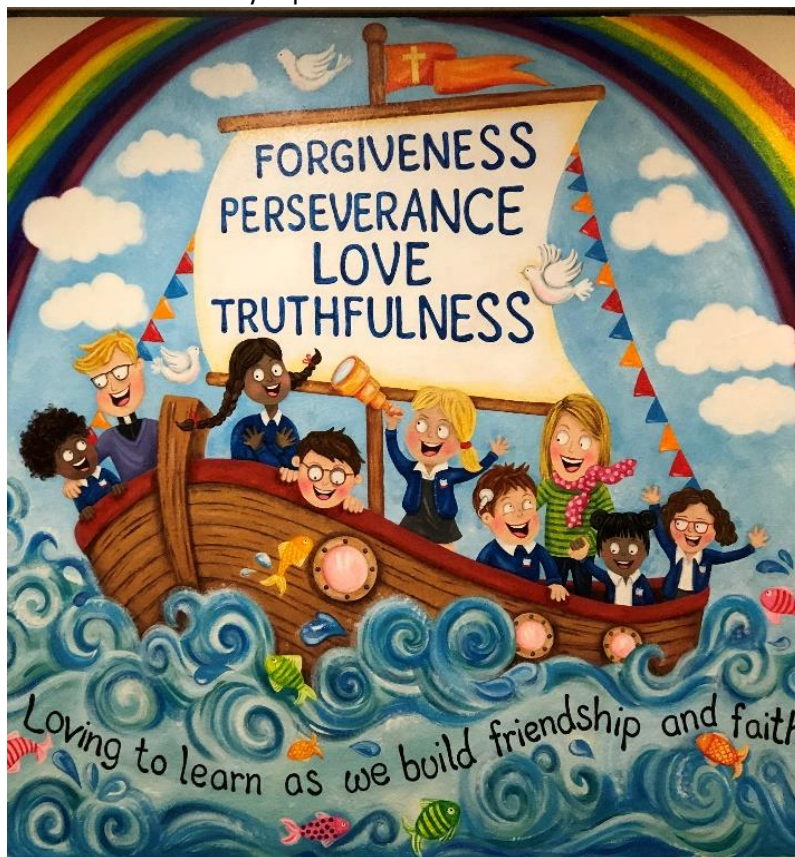
#### Our Values
