



Cavendish Junior School Uniform Checklist

Uniform – Available from www.myclothing.com	
**Navy blazer with logo	
White shirt (long or short sleeved)	
*School tie	
*Grey v neck jumper with or without logo	
Black skirt, trousers or leggings (not jeans or cargo pants)	
Grey or black socks or woolly tights	
Flat black “school” shoes with laces or velcro (not trainers). Black ankle or calf length boots are acceptable, but NOT Doc Marten type.	
Light blue checked dress in summer with white socks	
Sensible, dark, plain hair bobble.	
PE Kit (to be kept in school)	
*Plain black shorts	
*White T shirt, preferably bearing the school logo	
Black plimsolls and optional training shoes for outdoors	
Plain dark tracksuit for colder weather	
Soft drawstring bag	
Jewellery (including earrings) must be removed for PE and preferably not worn at all. Children are responsible for looking after any jewellery.	
Swimming Kit (when required)	
Swimming costume or trunks (not baggy swim shorts)	
Towel	
Swimming hat (optional)	
Soft drawstring bag	
Earrings (studs) – must be taken out for swimming and children are responsible for keeping them safely.	
Goggles – these may be worn if a permission form is filled out, signed and sent in.	
Miscellaneous	
*Sun hats – available from school in bucket, legionnaires or baseball style	
*School rucksack or bookbag	
Snack – fruit only	
*Water bottle – pupils are issued with a free school one every September.	
Old shirt or apron for art activities	
Separate football/sports kit (and shin pads) in a small bag if attending after school club

Please could the items below be provided in a named carrier bag which children should keep on their pegs. If suitable protective clothing is not supplied, your child will still take part in the activities but school cannot be held responsible for uniform getting dirty or marked/splashed.
