### Maths

- Recall and use equivalences between simple fractions, decimals and percentages including in different contexts.
- Divide proper fractions by whole numbers e.g.  $\frac{2}{3} \div 3$
- Multiply one-digit numbers with up to two decimal places by whole numbers.
- Solve problems involving the calculation of percentages and the use of percentages for comparison.
- Solve problems involving unequal sharing using knowledge of fractions.

### Art and Design & Technology

- Children will improve their mastery of art and design techniques.
- Children will knit their own woollen hats.
