These rules help us to be fair to others and keep everyone safe.

- I will ask permission before using the internet
- I will only use my own login and password, which is secret.
- I will only look at my own files.
- I understand that I must not bring software, disks or memory sticks into school.
- I will only email people my teacher has approved
- The messages I send will be polite and sensible.
- I understand that I must never give my home
- address or phone number, or arrange to meet
- someone I do not know.
- I will not use internet chat.
- If I see anything I am unhappy with or I receive messages I do not like, I will tell a teacher immediately.
- I understand that school may check my files or the internet sites I visit.
- I understand that if I deliberately break these rules,

I may not be able to use the Internet or computers.

The school may exercise its right to monitor the use of the school's computer systems, including access to websites, the interception of email and the deletion of inappropriate materials where it believes unauthorised use of the school's computer system may be taking place, or the system is or may be being used for criminal purposes or for storing unauthorised or unlawful text, imagery or sound.
