National Curriculum

As Historians we will learn about the invasion of the Vikings into Britain and the impact it had on daily lives. We also learn about the different Gods and Goddesses that the Viking worshipped.

As Artists, we will learning to sketch our own Viking Gods and goddesses and using pastels and crayons to create artists impressions.

As Geographers, we will be learning about Viking values, voyages and victories and where these took place. We will also be identifying where famous raiding and trading took place and observing Viking transport between countries (UK and Europe)

As Design Technologists, we will be designing and making our own Viking pots. We will also be making our own Viking stew and serving it at our own Viking feasts, like they would have done all those years ago.

As part our our work on British values and philosophy for children we will be considerin equality and diversity and exploring our thoughts and feelings around this.

As RE experts, we will be considering the big question 'Why do Christians call the day Jesus died Good Friday?'

As PE experts, we will continue with our swimming targets and in Junior Jam, we are learning how to play a game of basketball. Our personal challenge this term is throwing and catching with accuracy.

As Musicians, we will be investigating how music was used to retell the stories of famous Viking sagas. We will listen to Viking sagas and write our own based upon these.

As ICT experts, we will be exploring programming using iPads and learning to produce our own information page about aspects of Viking life. We also be exploring the use of power point to share information with others.
