A selection of comments made by parents are below:

- I found the notification for events too short. I need more time to book time off to attend events. Why can't the information regarding events to be attended be given for the whole year at the start of the school year.
- Too much paper is given out - emails are used then backed up with paper - if parents have given email addresses then we do not need paper copies.
- I strongly believe my child has made excellent progress during her time at Jump Nursery.
- We only have one more year left of Jump Primary and I feel very sad about that. My eldest is now at Secondary and it is hard for any other school to measure up to the standard at Jump.
- My child has received structured support and challenge to excel in this year.
- I believe that bullying/tormenting is dealt with when it occurs, however, it seems to be the same names mentioned on more than one occasion. Kids are kids but some need nipping in the bud before they progress into something worse.
- The assessment section on school gateway needs updating. It may be a good idea if possible to show previous assessment levels, this will help to show progress more clearly.

Action to be taken by the school:

- Wherever possible we try to give as much notice as possible for events and at least with half a terms notice via my newsletter. Sometime events may be arranged by staff/companies external to the school and we don't always get the level of notice we would prefer either but this is sometimes beyond our control.
- We only send out paper copies when a reply form is needed or if the paper is being given out on behalf of someone else. We agree that we send too many emails (but it is only because we want to make sure you are well informed!) so we are going to try to ensure, where possible, that we only send you emails now on a Friday to save you having to check your emails as often. Texts will only be used for urgent reminders.
- The school gateway is updated half termly for children in Year 1-6 with assessment data. If you are seeing old data, then please contact the school staff to look into this for you. Unfortunately, only the current assessment level can be shown, but previous levels and progress can be discussed with class teacher at parent's evenings or at any other point during the year.

Thank you for all your comments. We value all your feedback and hope that you feel free to come in and speak to us (good or bad!) at any point during the year.
