As Scientists we might:

Find out about famous musicians from the area. Do they have a national anthem or song? Can you play or sing a piece from this country?

As ICT technicians we might:

Use purple mash to create your graphs, leaflets or presentations

As Athletes we might:

As Writers we might:

Write a list poem or an acrostic about this country and its features.

As Artists we might:

Use a tradition or technique from your chosen country to create some art. Research a famous artist and copy his/her style or technique in a painting.
