We will explore why Britain was invaded and settled by the Romans and what effects this had on the future of Britain. We will learn about the rise of the Roman Empire in Britain, opposition from the Celts, the legacy that was left behind when they went home, and much more.</p> <p>After half term, our topic will be all about Italy. We will learn about Italian culture and different places in Italy. The children will also have the opportunity to taste Italian food in our Italian cafe.</p>

The children will have plenty of opportunities to undertake practical experiments to help them understand the processes of evaporation and condensation, as well as expressing their understanding in a variety of ways.</p> <p>This term we will also be looking at changing sound.
