When Foundation came back after the holidays, we found some strange clues around the classroom. The children were fantastic detectives, writing and drawing the clues and using them to suggest who had left them. We discovered that Lanky Len and Hefty Hugh, the thieves from our story; What the Ladybird Heard, had been in our classroom whilst we were away. The children have really enjoyed reading the story and have been busy drawing maps and retelling it using the farm animals and masks.

We have also been talking about winter, as we have noticed the mornings getting frostier. We have been feeling, describing and carrying out experiments with ice and have created some beautiful snowflake artwork.



Class 1 & 2

Key Stage 1 started their new topic 'Explorers' and were very excited to explore the outdoor areas and mark their interesting finds on the map. We have also been thinking about places explorers might go and the things they need to take with them on their expeditions.

We have been looking at 2D and 3D shapes in maths, counting sides, vertices and faces to help us describe them. Owls printed with the 3D shapes to investigate the 2D shapes they could see. They even built some 3D shapes of their own using polydron!



Class 3

Class 3 have had a busy week, we have started looking at money values and have been counting using 1p's.

We have also been using our phonic skills to write CVC words. We do reversed integration with Class 2.... lots of playing, taking turns and working together.

We have been continuing with the story 'The Pig in the Pond', the children have enjoyed acting out the story and replacing some of the story words with their own words.

In P.E we have been learning to travel over the apparatus in different ways, some of us are really good at balancing!
