




Dear Parents


Religious Education

This term the children will be studying the Eucharist: Starting with The Gospels, the children will be reflecting on the words and actions of Jesus. They will then look closely at actions and parables followed by the sacraments. After this they will think about the Mass and how this is a celebration and how they have a responsibility to go to mass to receive Jesus. They will then be looking at the Easter story, reconciliation and The Eucharist. Year 4 will be preparing to receive the sacrament of the Eucharist.



English


- Through the History topic of The Tudors, the children will be writing Newspaper Reports and Stories with a Historical Setting.
- The children will also cover a range of genre through their extended writing lessons such as poetry and instructions.



Maths

During this term children will solve problems and mental calculations involving:

- place value, including Roman Numerals
- addition and subtraction, including 4, 5 & 6 digit numbers
- multiplication and corresponding division facts
- shape, patterns, position and movement
- measurement of lengths, weight and time
- interpreting graphs and tables
- fractions




Science - Taught by Mrs Steele

Pupils will be studying Light and Sound and Electricity. They will be carrying out lots of investigative work.

Computing

This term's topics are spreadsheets and programming.



Homework

The first half term will be a topic-based homework. A separate letter has been given out to explain this. However, the maths will continue to be weekly which will include Mathletics and Timetables Rock Stars. These are an excellent tool and really support the children in their Maths. Please do not forget to go over the Spelling Bee spellings for the whole half term too. The children will also continue to receive their weekly spellings.

The children are expected to read for at least 10 minutes each night. Please could you record this in their reading records. These can also be used as a form of communication regarding any important information, issues or concerns and I will be checking them every day.
