



Upper 2 – Spring 2019

SCIENCE – Light and Sight

Students will experience and explore: dark and light; sight and no sight. They will look at reflections of themselves and objects in mirrors. They will experiment with making shadows. Students will explore, sort, use group and identify and name objects which give light. They will explore safety issues. They will ask simple questions and record their findings.

PSHCE – Dreams and Goals/Healthy Me

Students will learn be helped to identify personal successes and achievements and enjoy them being celebrated. They will be encouraged to think of new challenges to tackle. Students will learn about healthy lifestyles and begin to recognise how to look after themselves and keep themselves safe.

ART- Colour

Students will use collage, painting and computer programs to develop and share their ideas, experiences and imagination on the theme of colour. They will learn about the work of a range of artists including Kandinsky, Mondrian and Matisse, describing the differences and similarities and making links to their own work.

DT - Toys

Students will explore commercially available toys and say why they like them. They will select from a range of materials and components, including constructions materials to make their own toys. They will explore and use different mechanisms, such as wheels and axles, in their toys.

GEOGRAPHY – European Awareness

Students will experience, explore and relate to European Awareness by use of the Internet, PowerPoint, maps, music and video. They will receive multi-sensory experiences of European countries e.g. taste foods, smell scents, explore products, hear languages.

HISTORY – Toys

Students will experience, explore and recognise toys from the present and the past. They will make a timeline of toys using information from a questionnaire completed at home. Students will explore how toys have changed from when their grandparents were young to those that they play with themselves.

COMPUTING – We are Treasure Hunters

Students will program a toy to move around a map to find buried treasure. They will start by thinking of algorithms for their routes and then input these as programs for the Beebot. They will learn about Online Safety as part of Safer Internet Day 2019 and who to go to for help if they need it.

RE – Symbols, Artefacts and Art

Students will use all their senses to explore different religious artefacts including crosses, articles for worship and religious clothing. They will learn how the different artefacts are used to express beliefs in places of worship and in the home. They will be encouraged to role play worship and repeated actions using religious artefacts.

MUSIC – Music Through the Decades

Students will listen to a range of classical and popular music from 1940's all the way up to the present day. They will be given opportunities to learn and perform songs and dance movement from different decades. Students will have the opportunity to play musical instruments including using iPad apps and to perform to the class.

PE – Invasion Games

The students will take part in different invasion games including, football/tag rugby/ball games. They will learn ball skills, passing/throwing/catching. The students will take part in a range of dance lessons covering different dance styles and using iMoves.

Rock Challenge

Students will work in class groups and as a whole team to prepare and rehearse their performance for the Rock Challenge competition. They will perform their work to a paying audience at Bridlington Spa and compete against other schools for a variety of achievement awards.
