Pupil Premium Grant Allocation – 2015-16

Hindley Green CP School’s Pupil Premium Grant for 2014/15 was **£121,700**
Pupil Premium allows us to target pupils eligible for free school meals and children in care to help them achieve their full potential.

As a school we have identified pupils and used the £121,700 to target additional support as follows:

- Staffing to implement small-group intervention programmes
- Focussing on nurture and raising self-esteem programmes
- Enabling individual and small group tuition in English and Maths across the school
- Counselling sessions
- Focussing on reading and phonic development in KS1 and Early Years
- Appointing a Music specialist to ensure the engagement of learners in quality music provision and to encourage children to nurture and develop musical talent
- Resources to enable children to access all areas of the curriculum, support learning, improve attendance and increase participation in after school clubs
- Funding of all trips for children entitled to free school meals or ever 6 children

Impact

In 2014-15, of the children eligible for pupil premium funding, 76% achieved or exceeded expected progress in Reading; 78% achieved or exceeded expected progress in Writing and 71% achieved or exceeded expected progress in Maths.

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Hindley Green CP School’s Pupil Premium Grant for 2015/16 is **£118,800**
Following an evaluation of the impact of the Pupil Premium Grant in 2014/15 and after identifying pupils meeting the criteria, we intend to use this to support the following:
