As you may know Year 4 children will be visiting Hill End during the dates outlined above for a residential. A parent meeting will be held in school on Wednesday 20th March at 3.30pm in Class 10 to go over finer details about the trip. Please find below an outline of points that will be raised during the Hill End meeting and some further important information regarding what to bring. As usual, if there are any questions or concerns that come up following the meeting please let us know. We will be discussing the daily routine and learning sessions in the few weeks leading up to Hill End so please check your children's bookbags for this information.

Overleaf is a kit list and a list of suggested items along with medical forms that must be completed by 20th March.

Children should bring sufficient and practical clothing for the trip. We must emphasise that clothing will probably get dirty and may even get damaged or lost, so please bear this in mind when you are packing!

Children will need a packed lunch on their first day only. This should be in a disposable bag, please, not a lunch box. All other food is provided (including snacks and treats) so please **do not** send any food or sweets with your child. Could we also take this opportunity to remind you that electronic games and mobile phones are not allowed at Hill End, an emergency contact number will be made available nearer the time.

The total cost of this trip is £110. This includes accommodation, led sessions, food, transport and insurance. School is paying for the insurance. Please can you send a deposit of £50 (via ParentPay) by Friday 29th March. The remainder should be paid by Friday 3rd May. If you have any concerns about payment please come and speak to us as soon as possible.

Finally, childcare vouchers can be used in payment for this and if you have any questions please speak to Heather in the office. If you would like to pay in instalments please let us know and we will provide you with a payment card.

Kit List

The following is essential

- Any medication your child will/may need during the trip. This must be put in a sealed, named bag with clear instructions (for an adult to administer, if required). The medication must also be clearly labelled and named. This needs to be handed in to the class teacher SEPARATELY on the morning of the trip.

A strong bag (which your child can carry!!!) containing:

- A sleeping bag or sheet and duvet
- A pillow case
- A waterproof coat e.g. a kagoule or pak-a-mac.
- Wellington boots.
- Water bottle (as used in school)

In addition, we suggest (taking into consideration the weather at the time):-

- A torch with spare batteries.
- Old trainers – for outdoors
- Indoor footwear.
- Old trousers/shorts (jeans are NOT suitable as they are difficult to dry).
- Underwear (at least 3 pairs of socks and pants).
- A warm jumper or sweatshirt/fleece (plus spare).
- Three T-shirts.
- A towel.
- Nightclothes (pyjamas/nightdress).
- A wash bag with toothpaste, soap, flannel.
- Sun-hat/cap/cream.
- Disposable camera if you wish.

Please mark all clothing clearly with the owner's name or initials.
Please remember that your child must be able to carry their own luggage.
