



Pupil Premium Spending Plan 2018-2019

Our Aim: We are committed to using Pupil Premium Funding to raise the attainment and achievement of disadvantaged pupils, in order to close the gap between them and other pupils in our school and other pupils nationally.

We will fund a Pastoral Support Worker (two half days a week) to continue to offer social and emotional support and develop home school links.

We are continuing to fund additional SEN TA hours to support our disadvantaged pupils across school.

Our plans are set down in the table below in our main areas of need from the total pupil premium spend we have available, which is £42,080
