Thank you so much to those of you who responded to our recent parental questionnaire. We had 67 responses overall! Each parent is worth 1.49%

**Below is a summary of the findings: N.B %s are rounded for each answer so may account for some variation to figures. The specific %s will be available on school's website on an excel spreadsheet in parents section.**

**Notes:**

In some questions %s appear lower as many responded '**don't know.**' This was mostly as a result of parents saying they did not have experiences of this issue so could not comment on it e.g questions 6, 8 and 10 comments

**Next steps:**

The main question that received less agree/strongly agree was about homework. We will explore this further to ascertain parental views in more detail.

All other questions were mainly answered positively. Where %s are lower in several cases this is because parents do not have direct experience of such issues e.g. bullying/raising concerns.

We will also be looking in more detail at comments made by parents against specific questions to see if we can improve provision/communication.

The results will be published on the school's website in more detail as will a copy of this letter. As always we appreciate your feedback as it helps us reflect on our practice. We are very pleased that **100%** of parents that responded would **recommend our school to others**. This is testimony to the hard work and dedication of all our staff!
