



## KS3 Personal Qualities Criteria



### Prepared for Learning:

- 4 – **Excellent:** Always equipped, on time to lessons, in full uniform, respectful of the class teacher & others.  
3 – **Good:** Nearly always equipped, on time to lessons, in full uniform, respectful of the class teacher & others.  
2 – **Satisfactory.** Mostly equipped, on time to lessons, in full uniform, respectful of the class teacher & others.  
1 – **Unsatisfactory:** Rarely equipped, on time to lessons, in full uniform, respectful of the class teacher & others.  
**Abs – Absent:** Due to prolonged absence we are unable to make a valid assessment.  
**NS – New to School:** New to the School and therefore we are unable to make a valid assessment.

### Effort:

- 4 – **Excellent:** Use own initiative to extend learning, actively seeking to improve. Can work independently.  
3 – **Good:** Works well on all tasks, completing them to a high standard. Will actively seek guidance and support.  
2 – **Satisfactory:** Completes most work set, when guidance and support is given in order to remain on task.  
1 – **Unsatisfactory:** Lacks self-discipline and easily drifts off task. Work is often left incomplete.  
**Abs – Absent:** Due to prolonged absence we are unable to make a valid assessment.  
**NS – New to School:** New to the School and therefore we are unable to make a valid assessment.

### Homework:

- 4 – **Excellent:** Completes all homework on time to the highest standard, often going beyond the required task.  
3 – **Good:** Completes and attempts to do all tasks to a high standard.  
2 – **Satisfactory:** Completes homework the majority of the time to the required standard.  
1 – **Unsatisfactory:** Rarely or never completes homework.  
**Abs – Absent:** Due to prolonged absence we are unable to make a valid assessment.  
**NS – New to School:** New to the School and therefore we are unable to make a valid assessment.  
(If there is no grade in Homework, then this is because the deadline for independent learning has not passed)

### Behaviour:

- 4 – **Excellent:** Acts as a role model. Demonstrates exemplary behaviour at all times.  
3 – **Good:** Shows a positive and enthusiastic attitude. Remains focused at all times.  
2 – **Satisfactory:** Behaves well and has a positive attitude. Can be occasionally distracted.  
1 – **Unsatisfactory:** Shows a Negative attitude which affects their own and others learning.  
**Abs – Absent:** Due to prolonged absence we are unable to make a valid assessment.  
**NS – New to School:** New to the School and therefore we are unable to make a valid assessment.

The higher the total score, the better the overall performance in all areas.
