

Medium Term Planning Year 3 Art Power of Reading Spring 2019

<u>Week</u>	<u>Learning Intention</u>	<u>Outcome</u>
Week 1	L.I: To consider what makes a good front cover.	Introduce children to the book. Discuss front cover and what makes it appealing. Look at the illustrations. Children choose their own picture for the front cover. Sketch in art books. Share with a partner.
Week 2	L.I: To use pastels to create texture.	Give out children examples of how to draw a dinosaur. Children sketch in art books Using pastels draw their dinosaur very lightly on paper. Use pastels to colour in. Explain how to blend and also how to create texture.
Week 3 and 4	L.I: To use clay to sculpt a volcano.	Look at pictures of volcanoes. Discuss shape and texture. Give out some play dough so children can practice making the shape of a volcano. Give each child a piece of clay on a board to shape into a volcano. Leave to dry. Mixing paints with PVA glue, paint volcano.
Week 5	L.I: To paint a stone using small brushes.	Children bring in the stones they have been collecting. Design a picture to paint on their stone. Consider the shape of the stone Using small brushes and paint mixed with PVA glue paint their stone.
