

English Medium Term Plan: Year 3 Autumn 2017

Autumn 1	Weekly overview including Reading, writing and SPaG Objectives
Week 1	<p>Sentence Building</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To be able to identify the criteria for making sentences grammatically correct. The children will review what is needed to construct a suitable sentence. They will focus on the necessary punctuation, as well as other forms of punctuation which can be used and when to use them. Activities will also include opportunities to edit and improve existing sentences so that they make sense.
Week 2	
Week 3	<p>The Gruffalo</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Using the Gruffalo as the stimulus text children will write a short description about a character making sure they can highlight evidence from the text to support their descriptions. Children will analyse the use of punctuation and grammar within the text and investigate how it is used to avoid ambiguity when trying to understand the story. Through role-play and storyboards children will create recounts of the story. Some children will be challenge to make alternative versions of the story. By doing so they will investigate how different actions could change to outcome of the story.
Week 4	
Week 5	<p>Play-scripts (The Gruffalo and The Witches)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The use speech marks correctly and understand the rules of speech. The use play scripts to perform an alternative version of 'The Gruffalo' Children will look at different stories which are told using play-scripts and will look at how stories can be converted into play-scripts.
