How to get to Villiers High School:

Villiers High School is located off the Southall Broadway, adjacent to Southall Park on Boyd Avenue.

On Arrival:

On arrival please report to the main reception. Car parking is available, but is limited and must be booked in advance with the school. There are three public parking bays at the front of the school limited to 1 hour.

By Road: From the North via M25:

M25 leave at Junction 15 join M4 heading central London (Heathrow) or M4 leave at Junction 3 towards (A312) head north. At the roundabout take the 3rd exit onto **Hayes Road** (0.4 miles). Continue onto **Western Road** (Go through 2 roundabouts 0.8 miles). Turn left onto **King Street**, which turns slightly right and becomes **The Green**. At the next roundabout take the 1st exit passing **Southall Station** on your right. At the traffic lights turn right on to **Park Avenue** (0.2 miles). Take the 2nd left onto **Villiers Road** (0.2 miles). Turn right onto **Boyd Avenue**.

OR

Take the A4020 exit toward Uxbridge/Hayes/Ealing/Southall. At the roundabout take the 3rd exit onto **Uxbridge Road/ A4020** (1.3 miles). Turn right onto **South Road**. Take the 1st left onto **Hamilton Road**. Turn right onto **Avenue Road** and left onto **Boyd Avenue**.

By Road: From the south via A40:

If travelling from the South or West via M25 exit at Junction 16 and join the M40 eastwards becoming the A40. If travelling from Central London and the East head for and join the A40, **towards A4020**.

- The nearest underground station is Southall Station
- The Station is only a short walk from the school
- Head north out of the station (Take a right out of the station)
- Turn right at the lights onto **Park Avenue** (0.2 miles)
- Turn left onto **Villiers Road** (0.2 miles) and right onto **Boyd Avenue**

- **120, 482, H32** (Coming from Northolt)

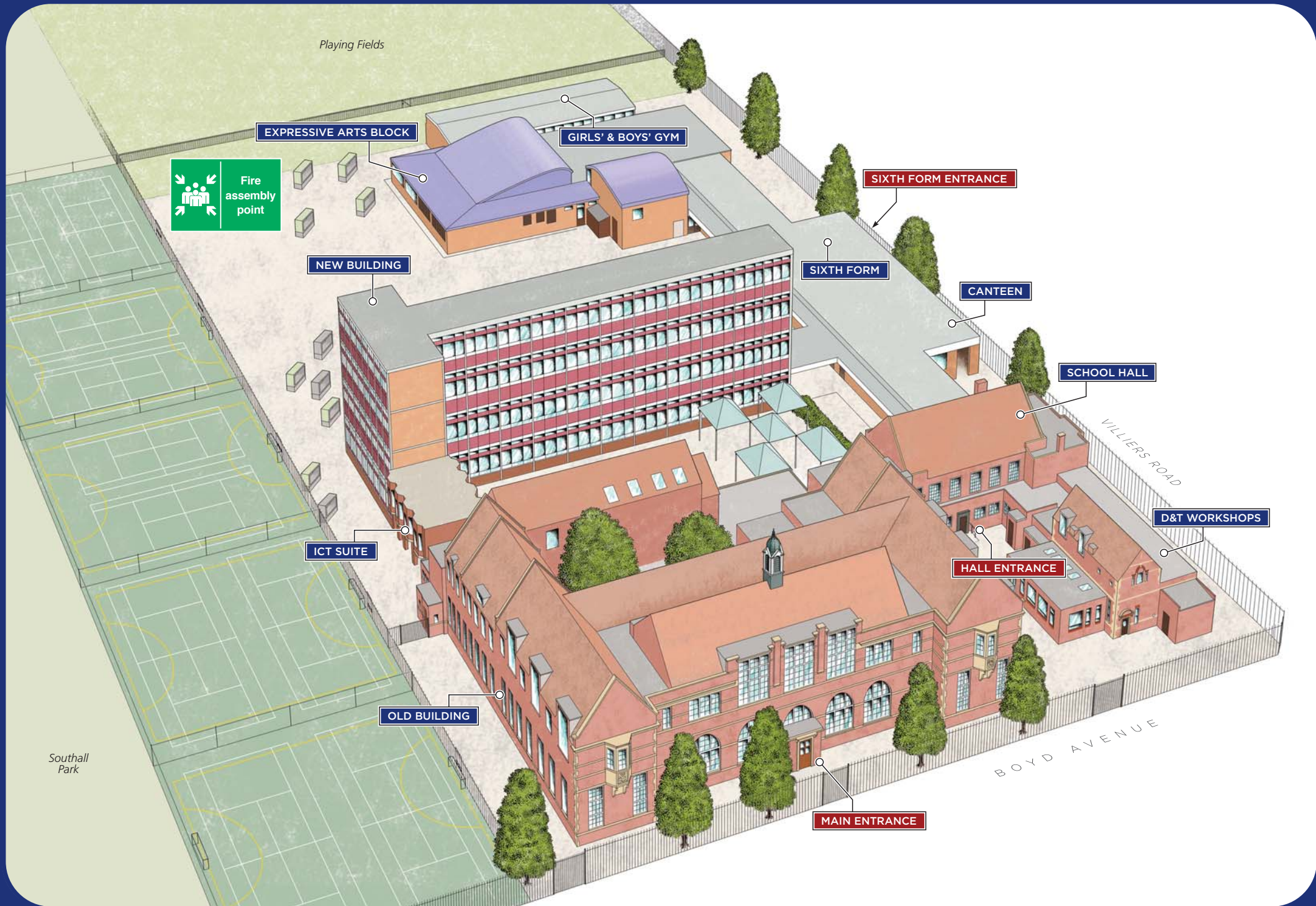
