Prime Areas

In Communication and Language, the children have been speaking about common themes in a Superhero story. They are beginning to talk about their own stories and characters.

In the outdoor area the children have been making a giant spider web for the children to explore and pretend to be Spiderman.

In Expressive Arts and Design the children have been making a Supertato using a real potato!

Specific Areas

In Literacy this week the children have continued to learn about all of the different special powers that a Superhero could have. We have been reading Superhero books and discussing the common themes in a Superhero story.

In Phonics, the children have been re-capping the sounds they have learnt so far and learning new phase 3 sounds. The new sounds they have learnt are: *y, z, zz, qu*

In Maths, the children have been continuing to learn about number bonds and writing the number sentences.
