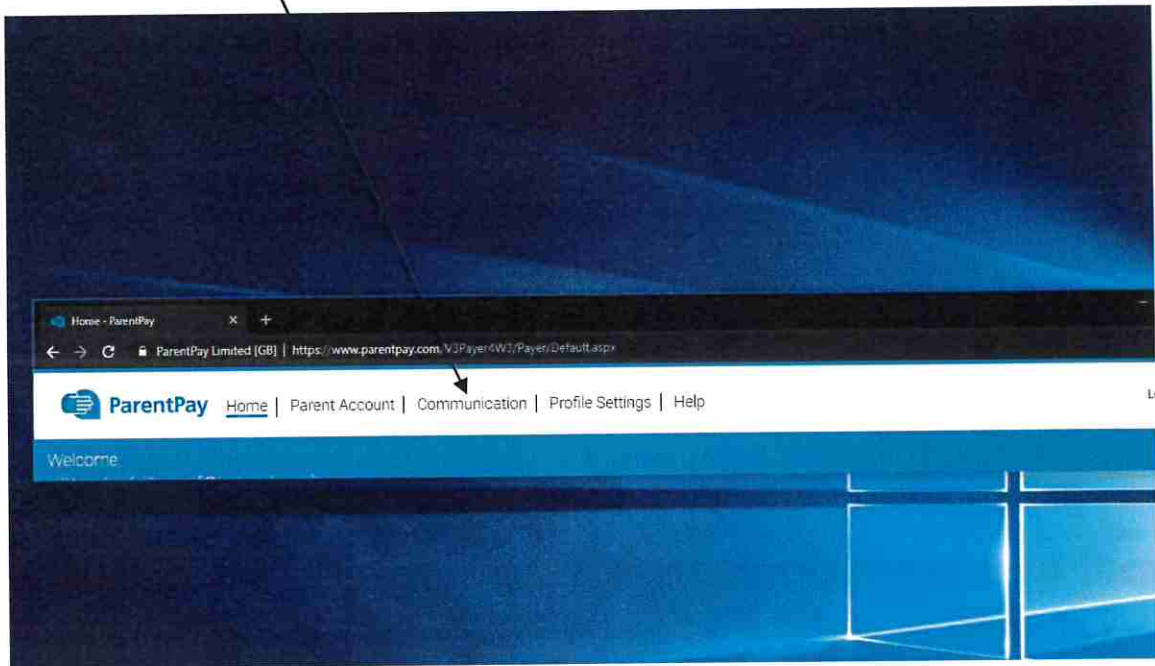

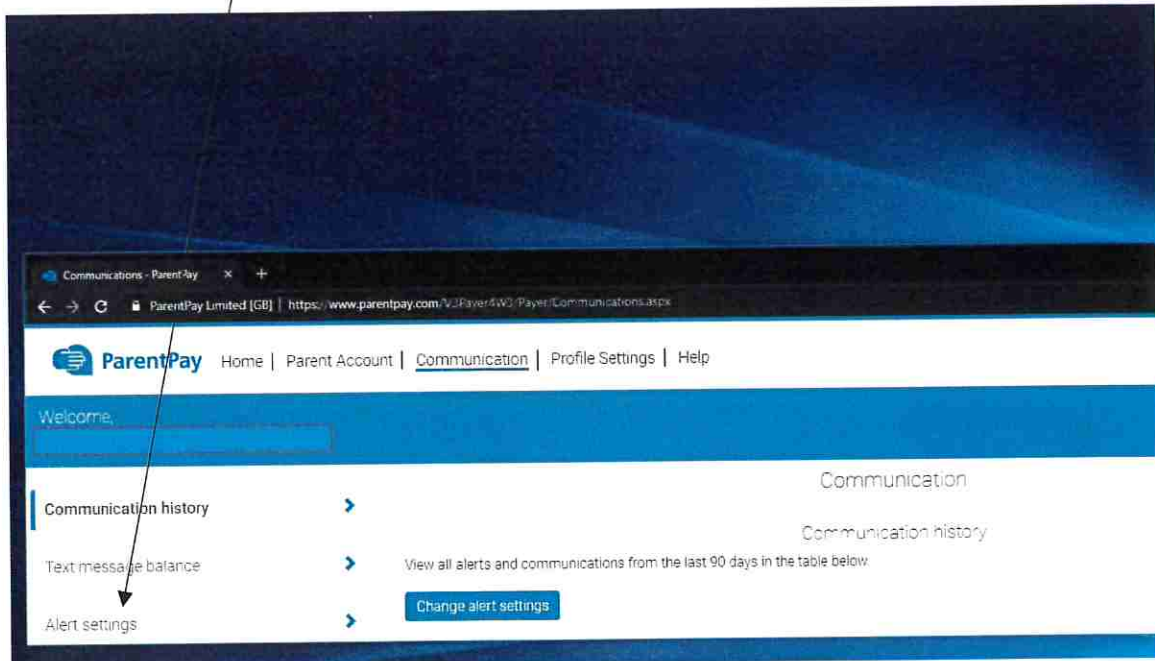

Parent Pay – Setting a low balance warning for School Meals

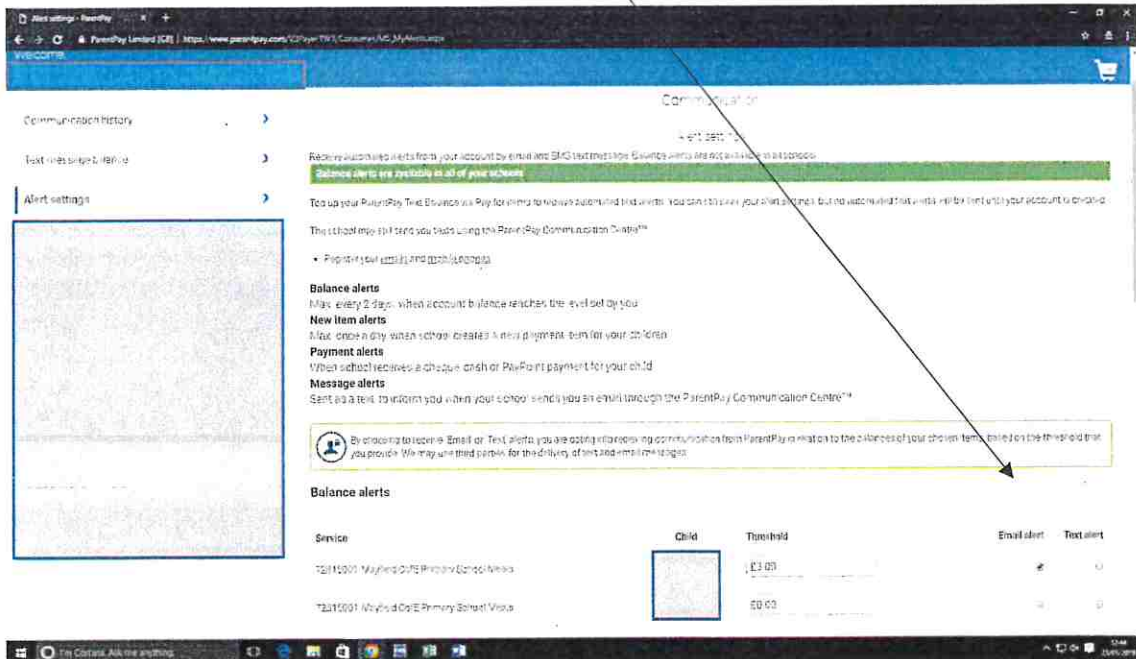
- Log in to parent pay
- Select **Communication** from the top menu bar



- Select **Alert Settings** from the side menu bar



- You then need to select the box for **Email alert** under **Balance alerts** and enter a **Threshold** at which you wish to be alerted. You will have to set a threshold for each child on your Parent Pay Account. You then **Save** this at the bottom of the page.



- You should then be all set up to receive an email from Parent Pay when your School Meals account balance dips below your threshold. When you receive these messages you can then top up your School Meals Balance through your Parent Pay account.

Please note that Email alerts are free of charge – if you select Text Message alerts you will have to pay for these.
