In geography, the children will:

- Name the countries in South America
- Identify the equator and the tropics of Cancer and Capricorn
- Discuss the economy of South America and its exports
- Name the different layers of the rainforest
- Explain how different tribes survive in The Amazonian Rainforest



In Literacy, the children will:

- Write news reports and a narrative linked to the class text
- Learn the spelling patterns -cious/-tious -tial/cial
- Use relative clauses, relative pronouns and adverbials in their writing
