Dear Parents

We would like to take the Reception children on two educational visits this year. The first is a trip to Zog at the Swan Theatre in High Wycombe on Thursday 14th March 2019, because our topic in spring two will be Julia Donaldson. The second is a trip to Rushmere Country Park in Leighton Buzzard on Friday 7th June 2019. Our topic in summer two will be fairytales and we want to encourage learning using the environment. The children will explore the woods, find a variety of wooden sculptures and they may even discover where fairies live.

Zog Play

The children will leave school at 9:15 am on the morning of Thursday 14th March and will return by 12:30pm in time for lunch. If your child normally has a school meal, they will have the choice of a ham or cheese roll. If your child normally brings a packed lunch from home, please ensure that they do this on the day. Your children will need to wear school uniform as normal.

Rushmere Country Park

The children will leave school at 9:00 am on the morning of Friday 7th June and will return by 2:50pm. If your child normally has a school meal, they will have the choice of a ham or cheese roll. If your child normally brings a packed lunch from home, please ensure that they do this on the day. Your child should wear their school sweatshirt with trousers or jogging bottoms and trainers. Please ensure your children dress appropriately to the weather. Sun cream must be applied before arriving at school, remember a sun hat and a water bottle filled only with water.

The VSA have generously offered to pay a contribution towards both trips which has helped to reduce the cost. The trip to Zog is £13.25 and Rushmere is £8.40. Please use the Wisepay facility for payment, returning the permission slips below to the school office by Tuesday 26th February. Payment for the trips can be made separately, please ensure the Zog payment is made by Tuesday 26th February and Rushmere is paid before Tuesday 30th April. If you cannot use Wisepay, please send in cash or a cheque with the permission slip in a named envelope. Please note that the trip can only go ahead if everyone pays, but in cases of genuine hardship financial help may be available. Please contact the school office for more information.

If your child suffers from travel sickness, please give your child a tablet at home on the morning. If one is needed for the return journey, this should be given to the child's class teacher in a named envelope, signed by the parent, and should include details of when and how it should be given. Please do not allow children to carry their own medication.
