DFE League tables

Each year, the Department for Education publish the league tables of best performing schools in each area based on KS2 results. We are proud to say that our school is ranked 5th in our local area with 82% of pupils meeting the expected standard for Reading, Writing and Maths; and 24% of children achieving greater depth. Nationally and in the Local Authority, 64 % of children reached the expected standard in the 2018 KS2 SATs. Greater depth was achieved by 10% of children nationally and 8% in the East Riding. Our children performed particularly well in Maths, with 94% of pupils achieving the expected standard.

Toilet Twinning

We are still aiming to twin with 9 toilets by the end of this year (1 for each toilet in school). So far, we have twinned with 4 toilets in the Majority World. If you would like to continue to support us in this endeavor, you are still able to 'spend a penny' in our entrance hall.
