Dear Parents and Carers,

This week I want to celebrate our PE and Sport provision. We have been awarded the Gold Award from School Games which is a government led scheme to recognise excellence in schools. For the third year running we have been the Newcastle school that has participated in the highest number of competitions. This is a fantastic achievement – some of these we have won or been placed in the first three – others we have not. It has included some competitions for Y1 and Y2 children as well as older pupils. The award also recognises the amount of extra-curricular provision that we have – before, during and after school – and of course during the holidays.
