

Mathematics

In maths they will be focusing largely on fractions before looking at 2D and 3D shape and regular and irregular polygons.

Linked through the term, the children will also be developing their problem solving skills through different investigations in particular, trial and error and working systematically.

Science

This term, children will be focusing on Earth and Space. They will learn about how we get night and day; How shadows are formed and information about how time zones are calculated.

English

The children will be looking at their creativity within writing a narrative. They will be exploring different ways in which a story can be improved through elements such as characterisation.

Later in the term, the children will again return to poetry, looking at how rhythm and flow can be achieved and maintained.

Linking across different subject areas, the children will write diary entries, letters and reports.

MFL

In French, the children will be learning how to describe their clothing, as well as simple phrasing.

History / Geography

This term, in History, Year 5 will be studying the lifestyles of both the Anglo Saxons. They will explore their way of life including elements such as languages, homestead and battle strategies.

D&T / Art

In art, the children will be researching and studying the construction and design of *Moving Toys*.

They will investigate *CAMS*, as well as designing, making and evaluating their own moving toy by the end of the project.

Religious Education

The children will be looking at Buddhism, Christianity, Judaism, Hinduism and how these religions are expressed through different symbols, the Arts and Scripture. They will be examining how these Religions have similar or different beliefs to their own and how they can link them into their own lives

Music

Children will learning how to read musical notation and will learn how to play basic chords on the ukulele.

Later in the term, the children will combine their knowledge and ability playing the ukulele alongside their continually improving singing.

P.E.

Children will be focusing on their netball skills. They will learn how to pass in different ways, how to shoot as well as learning the rules of the game and tactics.

Additionally, the year 5 children will be attending swimming each week as they work to secure an effective and consistent stroke.

Computing

In computing, the children will be looking at creating algorithms through 'Scratch' and create their own game which will include a maze. They will write their own programmes and debug them for mistakes.

PSHE

Children will be exploring their hopes, dreams and aspirations. They will engage in discussion regarding their dream jobs and also considering the steps required in order to reach these targets.
