**FEAST OF THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD**  
**HOLY MASS & BLESSING OF ST EDWARD'S**  
**NEW ENTRANCE & DOORS**

The doors of the church, particularly the main doors, and the narthex, the space at the entrance to the church building, together form a threshold which people cross as they make the transition from the ordinary world to the worshipping community. They mark out a place where the stranger will begin their encounter of the Church at prayer and the place where the Church will formally welcome the stranger who seeks admission not just to the building but to the community of the Church. Thus it is at the entrance to the church that those seeking membership of the Christian community are admitted into the Order of Catechumens; that baptismal and wedding parties are welcomed as they approach the sacraments; here too families grieving the loss of a loved one are greeted and the coffins of the deceased are sprinkled with holy water as a reminder of their first dying in Christ in baptism which contains the promise that in this second death they will rise with him in glory. Every Sunday this place of entry to the church is a place of welcome and greeting for the community.

**"We praise You, Lord God, Father all-holy, You sent Your Only Son into our world to gather by the shedding of His blood those whom the destructive power of sin had scattered. You sent Him to unite us all in the one sheepfold. He is the Good Shepherd; HE IS THE DOOR through whom those who follow Him enter and are safe, go in and out, and find pasture."**
