Parent's Evening

P.E

P.E is an extremely important part of our curriculum as we want to promote 'healthy bodies, healthy minds'. Therefore, all children should have their **full P.E kit** at school every day. This also means that the children should be wearing their outside P.E kits as per our uniform policy above.

Breakfast Club

Breakfast club is open every day from 7.45-8.15am, the cost is £3.50 per session. Children arriving after this time **will not** be able to have breakfast. You can drop your children off from 8.30 am onwards for a charge of £1.00.

After School Club

Afterschool club is open until 5.30 pm every day and the cost is £3.50 per hour and this includes a snack. If you would like your child to attend, please speak to one of the after school club team or contact the school office. **Bookings need to be booked in advance and paid for in advance** as the club is extremely busy at the moment. If you have booked a place but your child is unable to attend, please let the office know so we can free up a place for others. **Outstanding payments need to be paid, otherwise your child will be prohibited from attending future sessions.**

Parents need to let the staff know daily who the adult is that will be picking their child up from after school club.

Pupil Premium children

If your child is Pupil Premium, you still need to let the staff know in advance if your child will/will not be Attending breakfast/after school club. **Failure to do this will result in your child not receiving a future place at the club.**

Snow Alerts

At this time of the year we are always vigilant when it comes to the weather. When snow is imminent we do our best to inform parents of any closure as far in advance as we can. It is always very difficult to make the decision to close as we know how much it affects working families. However, we will always make our decision based on the safety of our children and staff.
