# When? Where? How?

- Departing from school at **2.15pm** on **Monday 11<sup>th</sup> February**
- Children to arrive at school at **normal** time, **with their suitcases.**
- You can come through the front entrance to drop your suitcase off in the hall.
- **Do not wear uniform-** PE kit-esque clothing should be fine
- The bus will be leaving here at 2.15pm, you are welcome to come and wave the bus off
- We are going to Liddington- about an hour away

# What to bring

- Kit list is on the school website under 'PGL 2019'
- There are a few paper copies available today if you'd like one.
- Do NOT bring spray deodorant or hairspray (not that you would bring hairspray but just thought I'd say it)
- Do not put food (sweets or snacks) into suitcases
- Bring extra socks...many socks... additional socks...
- There will be a disco on the last evening, so bring one pair of nice\* clothes
- \*Jeans and a clean shirt.. Long top and clean leggings.. Nothing too fancy...

# Medical

- There will be an adult on each floor assigned to medicines and such.
- You should have put any medical information onto the medical form- if you need to add anything additional please let the office know.
- Medicine should be in a plastic zip lock bag which is clearly named with the dosage and timing
- Medicines can not be shared unless pre-consented.
- Children should keep inhalers on them and give to the adult in their group at the start of each activity – SHOULD BE NAMED.

# Rooms and groups

- Your children all put down people they would like to share a room with.
- That information was collated and children were put into groups by their class teachers as fairly as possible
- They will not find out which room they are in till the morning of PGL
- They will find out the groups they are in a couple of days before PGL
- We are not able to change rooms, they have been strategically and logically placed by your child's teacher.

# Contact

- The PGL page of the website will be updated as much as possible
- Texts from myself giving main updates will be sent when possible... but not too often... lets not get carried away
- Children will not be able to contact you during the trip... no phone calls
- We have all emergency contact details- that you gave to us on the medical form, and will be in contact if needed.
- If anything does happen, please contact the school who will be able to contact me in case on an emergency.
