Welcome

Welcome to Skipsea Primary School Nursery. Our Nursery forms part of the Foundation Stage Unit (FSU), which supports and enables the learning of the youngest members of the school.

Skipsea Primary School caters for pupils aged 3 to 11.

The Nursery is available for children aged 3-4 and offers an immersive and varied learning environment that offers a great springboard into school life.

As we are a small and tight-knit school, children who attend the Nursery take part in wider school life such as participating in celebrations, Forest School trips and sports activities.



Our Setting

The children who attend the Nursery share their provision with children who attend the school in Reception. Our unit offers a broad range of learning experiences both indoors and outdoors. We believe strongly in enabling parents and carers to share in their child's learning, therefore we run weekly Stay and Play sessions as well as an online learning journey system so that parents can stay up-to-date on school life.



Hours

3-4 year olds are entitled to at least 15 hours free childcare a week. The most popular option for using these hours are 9.00am - 12pm each weekday morning.

Our Nursery is flexible on hours that we can provide, including full days. Please get in contact to discuss your childcare requirements.
