

Your child's next topics will be:

- Fairy Tales / Traditional Stories

During this term, your child will learn:

- How to make a puppet
- Fairy Tales - stories, drama, art work and Fairy Tales with a 'twist'
- Forces and Scientific Investigation

The children will concentrate on:

- Solving mathematical problems
